II. Strategy discussion

The meeting focused on reviewing the draft strategic plan for the Research Park, with emphasis on the three proposed pillars of real estate asset consolidation and oversight of uses in the Research Park, ecosystem activation and placemaking, and Research Park company synergies with Florida Atlantic University. Adhering to the statutory definition of a research and development park was a unanimous consensus.

The Authority examined metrics and goals for various strategic pillars, including tenant relationship management, ecosystem activation, and food and beverage options, while discussing the need for additional staff resources to operationalize company relationships and track compliance with research commitments. They also explored opportunities for signature events, amenities development.

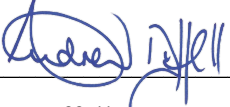
The conversation highlighted financial constraints due to expected property tax reform affecting public funding. The benefits of using the Authority's 501(c)(3) entity to pursue additional funding sources for Global Ventures operations were explored.
